The Dominican triad of Meister Eckhart, Henry Suso, and John Tauler, taught about the contemplative life of prayer. Tauler, 1300-1361, spoke to the laity who were looking for a more intense inner prayer life, but could not comprehend what to do with Eckhart's "grunt." Tauler, more practical, focused on abandonment to transitory things, and a non-clinging to our special devotions. "We cannot be led by God to our deepest ground if we do practices only of our own choosing," said Tauler, and added, "If you don't want to travel a higher road, then forget what I am saying." Tauler will be compared and contrasted with others in the contemplative tradition.
