Albert the Great was the mentor of Thomas Aquinas, both Dominicans, in the 13<sup>th</sup> century. Through Albert, Thomas became interested in philosophical writings recent and ancient. Albert spoke of the Darkness of Unknowing, where God is more than we can say about God. Meister Eckhart, also a Dominican, was a follower of Albert's teachings. Thomas wrote a systematic theology of faith seeking understanding. He is the proponent of Scholasticism. The contemplative life needs an inner leisureliness to arrive at Truth through Love.
